

CONFERENCE SPEAKERS



THE MOST REVEREND ROBERT G. CASEY serves as the Tenth Archbishop of Cincinnati. A native of Alsip, Illinois, he attended Mundelein Seminary, where he earned a Master of Divinity Degree in 1994. He was ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Chicago that same year. After serving in three roles as pastor, Archbishop Casey was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Chicago on July 3, 2018, and ordained a bishop on September 17, 2018. He became Vicar for Vicariate III and, in 2020, was named Vicar General of the Archdiocese of Chicago. Archbishop Casey was appointed Archbishop of Cincinnati on February 12, 2025, and installed to this archbishopric on April 3, 2025



THE VERY REVEREND ANTHONY R. BRAUSCH was ordained in 2002 and is the President/Rector of Mount St. Mary's Seminary and School of Theology, appointed by Archbishop Schnurr in May, 2018. Father's previous assignments include parochial vicar and the administrator of Our Lady of the Visitation Parish, Cincinnati as well as faculty member of Elder High School. He has been a member of the teaching and formation faculties at Mount St. Mary's Seminary and School of Theology since 2008 and was appointed Vice-Rector/Director of Formation for the Seminary and Director of Formation of the Permanent Deacon Program in 2011.

Fr. Brausch holds a bachelor's degree in philosophy from the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio; a Masters of Divinity from the Athenaeum of Ohio; and, a licentiate and doctorate in philosophy from the Gregorian University in Rome.



REV. ANDREW MOSS was ordained in 2010 and is a priest of the Diocese of Columbus. He serves as Coordinator of Pastoral Formation at the Pontifical College Josephinum and as Assistant Professor of Canon Law. Previously he was a Seminary Formator and Instructor of Canon Law at Mount St. Mary's Seminary & School of Theology (MTSM).

Fr. Moss was originally ordained for the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton in the UK, having earned a licentiate in canon law from St. Paul University and a baccalaureate in sacred theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. In addition, he holds a licentiate in jazz studies from the Guildhall School of Music, London, and a Bachelor of Arts in music from York University, England.

Fr. Moss has served the Church in a variety of assignments including that of pastor, vice chancellor and marriage tribunal judge.



REV. DAVID J. ENDRES was ordained in 2009, was appointed Dean at The Athenaeum of Ohio in 2016. Currently, he is Dean of The Athenaeum of Ohio, Dean of Mount St. Mary's Seminary, Professor of Church History and Historical Theology and is a member of the Formation Team. After ordination, Father taught at Fenwick High School. He was then assigned to teach at the Seminary. He led the Bicentennial Committee for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati and was appointed director of the Priests' Personnel Office in 2019. He is the Editor of the *US Catholic Historian* and is author of a number of books and articles and is a regular contributor to *The Catholic Telegraph*.

Fr. Endres has a BA from Xavier University, and M.Div. from the Athenaeum of Ohio and an MA and Ph.D. from The Catholic University of America.

MICHELE MACEDONIO, MS is a retired registered, licensed dietitian, is a Board Certified Specialist in Sports Dietetics and owner of Nutrition Strategies®, LLC. Academically, she holds a BS degree in Nutrition and Dietetics from Marywood University, as well as Master's degrees in Nutrition and in Health Sciences Education from Case Western Reserve University. Ms. Macedonio has worked with a variety of people from youth through professional athletes including Xavier University and University of Dayton Men's Basketball teams and was the Cincinnati Bengals and Cincinnati Reds team dietitian.

She has volunteered and served in leadership positions for a number of groups and committees in the sports nutrition arena and was awarded the SCAN Achievement Award and the Excellence in Practice Award.

REVEREND ZACHARY CECIL is the pastor of the parishes that make up the St. John Bosco Family of Parishes (St. Lawrence, St. Teresa of Avila, St. William and Resurrection of Our Lord) on the West Side of Cincinnati. He was ordained in 2019. Father Cecil was assigned as Parochial Vicar to St. William and St. Teresa of Avila and became pastor of the same in 2021. In 2022, with the Beacons of Light process, he became Pastor of all four parishes in the family.



Fr. Cecil has a Masters of Divinity and a Master of Arts in Biblical Studies from Mt St. Mary's Seminary and School of Theology. He was raised in Piqua, Ohio and was a member of St. Mary's Parish, Piqua.
